Progress continues at the Akpe Cultural Center. This past summer, we poured the columns to support the second floor. With that done, when we have more funds, we will pour the next floor and build the walls up to meet it. At that point, the lower level will be weather tight, and we can install our dance floor.

That's a critical milestone for two reasons: One, our suspended, resilient dance floor will be the only one in the region, and much in demand. Two, because of that, we can immediately start teaching and hosting events at the Akpe Cultural Center, and the project will begin to generate income to help support construction of the two remaining floors.
